What is a “Place of Welcome”?

Places of Welcome is a network of small community organisations, including faith communities, who offer an unconditional welcome to local people for at least a few hours a week.

They run under five principles:

Place: An accessible and hospitable building, open at the same time every week.

People: Open to everyone regardless of their circumstances or situation, and staffed by volunteers.

Presence: A place where people actively listen to one another.

Provision: Offering free refreshments (at least a cup of tea and a biscuit) and basic local information.

Participation: Recognises that every person coming to a Place of Welcome will bring talents, experiences and skills that they might be willing to share locally.

Why in Swanage?

Link Visiting Swanage was established in 2015 to provide 1:1 befriending to older isolated people through weekly home visits.

But there are many people (not just older) who can get out but still feel isolated.

We are planning to open our small premises on Tuesday and Friday mornings (10-12), offering a free drink & biscuit, a listening ear and basic information.
